# **Capital Projects Update**

#### James St. Doors

Both sets of external doors on James St. need to be replaced due to damaged hinges and misaligned frames. Quotes for replacement have been requested.

## **Universal Washroom / Washrooms**

For our church building to continue to be used, a universal washroom must be in place by 2025. Alan Avis Architects has been contracted to complete a review of our physical structure and determine the optimum use of space and associated changes needed. A schematic design has been received, reviewed and approved. This includes the creation of a janitor's closet, universal washroom, minor changes to the men's washroom and an upgrade to the women's washroom. A full design for all changes is now being developed. Once this design is received and approved, estimates for construction will be obtained.

#### **South Huron Arts Centre Partnership**

The South Huron Arts Centre will make its home at Exeter United Church.

This is a natural fit with our vision of "Open Arms, Open Hearts, and Open Spirit" and will lead to our building once again becoming a vibrant facility in our community.

Minor facility renovations will be allowed with costs borne by the Arts Centre. Approval has been given for installation of a kiln, counter, and sink in the Social Hall.

Storage space will be provided. Approval has been given to designate some space and rooms in the basement for use by the Arts Centre. This has resulted in items being relocated to other areas and rooms.

The Arts Centre will carry their own insurance.

The Arts Centre will be a long-term tenant with low rent. No rent/utilities will be charged for the first 12 months of operation. A previously received United Church of Canada Spirit Grant has been approved for use to offset increased first year utility costs.

A United Church of Canada Innovation Grant was applied for and received to support Art Centre start-up costs.
